I. <u>NEXT STATUS CONFERENCE</u>

A Status Conference will be held <u>Thursday, May 31, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. EDT</u> in Courtroom 1105 of the Thurgood Marshall United States Courthouse, 40 Centre Street, New York, New York.

II. <u>RELATED CASE UPDATE LETTERS</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, the parties should include in their monthly related case joint update letter a breakdown on the status of claims subject to Order No. 140 procedures, motions to withdraw, Wave One discovery, *etc*.

III. WAVE DISCOVERY

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss at the next status conference the issue of additional cases being added to the Wave discovery process, including the timing for beginning Wave Two.

IV. <u>ELECTRONIC POWER STEERING CASES AND CASES ALLEGING</u> <u>DEFECTS OTHER THAN IGNITION SWITCH DEFECTS</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss at the next status conference whether cases alleging defects other than ignition switch defects (including electronic power steering defects) should remain in the MDL.

V. <u>IMPLEMENTING A PROCESS SIMILAR TO ORDER NO. 140 FOR PRE-SALE</u> <u>ACCIDENT PLAINTIFFS</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, by Thursday, April 5,

2018, the parties should submit a joint proposed order modeled after Order No. 140 for the pre-

Sale accident plaintiffs and, if necessary, joint or competing letters regarding the parties' disputes,

if any.

VI. <u>STATUS OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEEDINGS WITH RESPECT TO "NON-</u> <u>IGNITION SWITCH PLAINTIFFS"</u>

By **Thursday, April 5, 2018**, the parties should submit letters (not to exceed five singlespaced pages) regarding the status of proceedings in the Bankruptcy Court with respect to the issue of whether "Non-Ignition Switch Plaintiffs" could demonstrate a due process violation by Old GM or whether the free and clear provision of the Sale Order applies.

VII. <u>CHOICE OF LAW BRIEFING FOR PRE-SALE ACCIDENT SUCCESSOR</u> <u>LIABILITY PLAINTIFFS</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, counsel for New GM and Lead Counsel should be prepared to address at the next status conference the timing for choice-oflaw briefing regarding personal injury or wrongful death pre-Sale accident plaintiffs alleging successor liability claims against New GM.

VIII. ECONOMIC LOSS DAUBERT HEARING

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, the parties should meet and confer regarding appropriate procedures, hearings or experts, if any, to assist the Court in resolving anticipated *Daubert* motions in the economic loss bellwether case.

IX. <u>SETTLEMENT</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments at the Status Conference, the parties should continue

to keep the Court apprised of developments regarding settlement.
