IV. <u>BRIEFING SCHEDULE FOR WITHDRAWAL MOTION IN RELATED</u>
<u>BANKRUPTCY MATTER</u>

Consistent with the Court's comments on the record at the status conference, the Economic

Loss Plaintiffs must file their opposition to New GM's "Motion to Withdraw the Reference of

Economic Loss Plaintiffs' Rule 23 Motion," No. 19-CV-1852 (JMF), Docket No. 1, by March 22,

2019. New GM shall file its reply by March 29, 2019.

V. PLAINTIFF TRACKING SPREADSHEET

Consistent with the discussions on the record at the status conference, the parties shall

submit a spreadsheet to the Court each month that contains up-to-date information about the

remaining wrongful death/personal injury plaintiffs, including any upcoming deadlines in each

plaintiff's case and which orders each plaintiff's claims are subject to.
