**ORDER NO. 54**

JESSE M. FURMAN, United States District Judge:

**[Regarding Motions To Remand Filed in Transferor Courts]**

Plaintiffs in the above-captioned cases filed motions to remand prior to transfer of their cases to this multi-district litigation. Pursuant to Order No. 1, “any and all pending motions in the transferor courts are denied without prejudice, and will be adjudicated under procedures set forth in this Order and subsequent orders issued by this Court.” (Order No. 1 (14-MD-2543 Docket No. 19) at 11).

In light of the foregoing, Plaintiffs shall file any renewed motions to remand (in **both** 14-MD-2543 and their individual member case) no later than **May 20, 2015**, and shall include citations to Second Circuit law in the accompanying memorandum of law. *See In re Gen. Motors LLC Ignition Switch Litig.*, No. 14-MD-2543 (JMF), 2014 WL 4636459, at \*1 n.1 (S.D.N.Y. Sept. 17, 2014) (“When an action is transferred pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1407 . . . the transferee court must apply its interpretations of federal law, not the constructions of federal law of the transferor circuit.” (internal quotation marks omitted)). New GM’s opposition(s) shall be filed no later than **June 3, 2015**; Plaintiffs’ replies, if any, shall be filed by **June 10, 2015**.

Finally, New GM shall advise the Court no later than **May 11, 2015** of any other motions to remand that were previously filed in cases currently in the MDL of which it is aware. Further, going forward, New GM shall advise the Court of any motion to remand filed in a case prior to its transfer to the MDL within **two weeks** of the case’s transfer to the MDL.

The Clerk of Court is directed to docket this Order in 14-MD-2543 and all above-captioned member cases.
