JESSE M. FURMAN, United States District Judge:

[Regarding Pretrial Deadlines for Bellwether Trial No. 5, Jury Selection Matters, Scheduling of the Final Pretrial Conference, and Application of Certain Pretrial Orders in MDL Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2 to MDL Bellwether Trial No. 5 (*Cockram*)]

1. **Courtroom**: Bellwether Trial No. 5 will begin on **Monday, September 12, 2016**. The Court plans to hold the trial in Courtroom 1105 of the Thurgood Marshall United States Courthouse, with a room reserved to accommodate any overflow of spectators. The Court will consider conducting certain trial proceedings — such as jury selection, opening statements, and closing arguments in a larger courtroom, but would arrange an overflow room for spectators regardless. The parties would still have access to "war rooms" on the fifth floor of the Thurgood Marshall Courthouse (assuming such rooms are available). By no later than **Friday**, **July 1, 2016**, the parties shall advise the Court by joint letter if they believe Courtroom 1105 is not a suitable location for the trial.

2. **Pretrial Deadlines**: Order No. 91 (Docket No. 2001, as modified by Order No. 97 (Docket No. 2396) and Docket No. 2682) set pretrial deadlines for Bellwether Trial No. 5. The Court now believes some of those deadlines should be modified. The following schedule and the chart at the end of this Order summarize all upcoming pretrial deadlines for Bellwether Trial No. 5, with modifications to the existing schedule underlined and modifications to the parties' proposed schedule italicized: a. **Amended Complaint**: Plaintiff filed her second amended complaint on April 13, 2016. New GM shall respond to plaintiff's second amended complaint by no later than **Wednesday, May 25, 2016**.

b. **Dispositive** *Cockram* **Motions**: Dispositive motions will be due on *Friday, June 3, 2016*. Responses are due fourteen (14) days after filing of the respective motions. Replies are due seven (7) days after responsive briefs are filed. Unless the Court orders otherwise, memoranda shall comply with the page limits and other requirements set forth in this Court's Local Rules, except that reply briefs shall not exceed 15 double-spaced pages.

c. **OSI Disputes**: In accordance with the Court's guidance in Order No. 86 Section XV (Docket No. 1772) and at the February 23, 2016 Status Conference, plaintiff shall disclose her proposed OSIs by <u>**Thursday, May 5, 2016</u>** and file her supporting brief by no later than <u>**Thursday, May 12, 2016**</u>. Any response from New GM will be due on <u>**Thursday, May 26, 2016**</u>. The parties' respective briefs shall not exceed 35 doublespaced pages.</u>

d. Motions *in Limine*: The parties shall file all motions *in limine*, not to exceed 15 double-spaced pages per opening brief, by no later than *Friday, June 10*, <u>2016</u>. Responses, not to exceed 15 double-spaced pages per brief, are due fourteen (14) days after the filing of the respective motions. Replies, not to exceed five double-spaced pages, are due ten (10) days after responsive briefs are filed for the respective motions.

e. **Daubert Motions**: Omnibus Daubert motions, not to exceed 50 doublespaced pages per brief, will be due on <u>Thursday, May 12, 2016</u>. Responses, not to exceed 50 double-spaced pages per brief, are due fourteen (14) days after filing of the

respective motions. Replies, not to exceed 20 double-spaced pages per brief, are due seven (7) days after responsive briefs are filed.

f. **Joint Pretrial Order**: The parties shall submit their joint proposed pretrial order (consistent with the Court's Individual Rules and Practices for Civil Cases, except to the extent modified herein) by no later than <u>Tuesday, July 26, 2016</u>.

g. Witness Lists: By no later than <u>Monday, June 20, 2016</u>, the parties shall disclose their respective good faith lists of all witnesses whom they may potentially call at trial ("Initial Witness List"). The parties will not be permitted to call a witness not included on the Initial Witness List, absent extraordinary circumstances. By no later than <u>Wednesday, July 20, 2016</u>, the parties shall make available for deposition any witness from their Initial Witness List who has not previously been deposed in this matter. By no later than <u>Tuesday, July 26, 2016</u>, the parties will disclose their respective good faith lists of witnesses whom they intend to call at trial ("Will Call Witness List") and their respective good faith lists of additional witnesses whom they may call at trial ("May Call Witness List").

h. Exhibit Lists: Trial exhibit lists must be exchanged by no later than <u>Tuesday, July 26, 2016</u>. Branded copies of the parties' trial exhibits must be exchanged by no later than <u>Friday, August 5, 2016</u>. The parties may by mutual agreement add or subtract additional trial exhibits at any time after. The parties shall exchange objections to the identified trial exhibits on <u>Wednesday, August 17, 2016</u>. Each party may add up to ten (10) exhibits to its exhibit list by <u>Wednesday, August 17, 2016</u> without a showing of good cause or mutual agreement ("Free Exhibits"). The parties reserve their rights to make evidentiary objections to the Free Exhibits by <u>Wednesday, August 24, 2016</u>. The

parties are expected to meet and confer on any exhibit objections by <u>Wednesday, August</u>
<u>24, 2016</u>. Copies of all exhibits shall be submitted to the Court by <u>Wednesday, August</u>
<u>31, 2016</u>. Finally, stipulations regarding the authenticity of exhibits are due on
<u>Wednesday, August 17, 2016</u>.

Disclosure of Valukas Report and Statement of Fact Excerpts:
 Plaintiff will disclose the Valukas Report and Statement of Facts excerpts she intends to use at trial by <u>Friday, July 29, 2016</u>. Any disputes shall be submitted to the Court by <u>Wednesday, August 10, 2016</u>.

j. **Deposition Designations**: Each party shall submit deposition designations by no later than <u>Tuesday, July 26, 2016</u>. Counter-designations and objections to the original designations shall be submitted by no later than <u>Tuesday, August 9, 2016</u>. Letter briefs regarding categorical objections to deposition designation and counter-designations shall be submitted by no later than <u>Tuesday, August 16, 2016</u>. Any remaining deposition designation disputes shall be submitted to the Court by no later than <u>Friday, August 26,</u> <u>2016 or three days after the Court rules on the categorical objections, whichever is</u> *later*.

k. **Stipulations of Law and Fact**: The parties are encouraged to enter into stipulations of law and fact, if any, by <u>Wednesday, August 17, 2016</u>.

 Proposed Jury Questionnaire: The parties shall exchange a proposed summary of the case, a list of names, and any proposed modifications to the questionnaires used in Bellwether No. 2 by no later than <u>Wednesday, August 3, 2016</u>.
 Jury questionnaire disputes, along with the parties' proposed questionnaires, shall be submitted to the Court by no later than <u>Friday, August 12, 2016</u>.

m. **Proposed Jury Instructions and Verdict Form**: Proposed jury instructions and a proposed verdict form, whether a joint proposal or competing proposals, must be exchanged by no later than <u>Wednesday, August 3, 2016</u>. Jury instruction and verdict form disputes, along with the parties' proposed instructions and verdict forms, shall be submitted to the Court by no later than <u>Friday, August 12, 2016</u>. As with Bellwether Trial No. 1, the parties need not submit proposed language for standard and/or introductory instructions (on the role of the jury, burden of proof, etc.).

n. **Demonstrative Aides**: The parties shall exchange demonstrative aides reasonably anticipated to be used during opening statements (that is, anything that a party proposes to show the jury, whether it is likely to come into evidence or otherwise) by no later than <u>Tuesday, September 6, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. EDT</u> and shall raise any objections by <u>Thursday, September 8, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. EDT</u>. Any dispute shall be submitted to the Court by no later than Friday, September 9, 2016, at 12:00 p.m. EDT.

3. **Final Pretrial Conference**: The Court will hold the Final Pretrial Conference in Courtroom 1105 of the Thurgood Marshall Courthouse on <u>Wednesday, September 7, 2016, at</u> <u>9:00 a.m. EDT</u> (taking a break, as needed, to address the prospective jurors in connection with the written questionnaire discussed below). At the final pretrial conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss, among other things, how much time each side should be allocated at trial.

4. **Jury Selection**: In light of the Court's experience with jury selection in Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2, it intends to summon a venire of approximately 75 members for Bellwether Trial No. 5. The Court will use the same jury selection procedures for Bellwether Trial No. 5 that it used for Bellwether Trial No. 2. (*See* Order No. 94 (Docket No. 2183)). In accordance with those procedures, written jury questionnaires will be completed by prospective

jurors on <u>Wednesday, September 7, 2016</u>, and the parties will have until <u>Friday, September 9,</u> <u>2016 at 10:00 a.m. EDT</u> to review the questionnaires and to submit a list of jurors that both sides agree should be excused for cause. At that same time, the parties shall also submit a list of jurors that only one party believes should be excused for cause (with a brief explanation of the basis for such belief). The Court will review the parties various lists and will decide which, if any, of those jurors should be excused for cause. The Court will then conduct oral *voir dire* of the remaining prospective jurors on <u>Monday, September 12, 2016</u>, beginning at 9:30 a.m. EDT.

5. **Extensions**: Given that **Monday, September 12, 2016**, is a firm trial date, the Court is unlikely to grant any extensions of the foregoing dates and deadlines absent extraordinary circumstances or confidence that the extension would have no effect on the trial date. The parties may also by written agreement extend deadlines to exchange information or documents provided that any such extensions would have no effect on the trial date. In accordance with the Court's Individual Rules and Practices for Civil Cases, any request for an extension shall be filed as a letter motion on ECF.

6. **Application of Certain Pretrial Orders in Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2 to Bellwether Trial No. 5:** The parties will submit a joint show cause proposal and any competing letter briefs regarding the applicability of certain pretrial rulings from Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2 by **Friday, May 6, 2016**.

7. Show Cause Briefing With Respect to the Applicability of Other Evidentiary Rulings in Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2: The parties are ordered to meet and confer and, by no later than <u>Monday, June 6, 2016</u>, to submit a joint proposal regarding a deadline to submit show cause briefing regarding the applicability of the Court's other evidentiary rulings from

Bellwether Trial Nos. 1 and 2 to Bellwether Trial No. 5 (including the Court's rulings on deposition designations, exhibits, and demonstratives).

8. Effect of This Order on Other Rules and Orders: To the extent not explicitly modified herein, the Court's Individual Rules and Practices in Civil Cases and Rules and Procedures for Trials and all other applicable Orders of this Court remain in full force and effect. The Court may enter additional and/or modified orders regarding the pretrial schedule of Bellwether Trial No. 5 as circumstances require.

9. **Summary of Pretrial Deadlines**: For ease of reference, the chart attached as Exhibit 1 to this Order summarizes all of the pretrial deadlines set forth above for Bellwether Trial No. 5. If any party should later move to amend any of these deadlines, that party shall submit as part of the letter motion requesting the extension a revised version of this chart with the proposed amendments.
