**[Regarding Motions for Admission *Pro Hac Vice* for
Attorneys of Record in Transferred Cases]**

To avoid any confusion, effective immediately, Order No. 2 (Docket No. 26) is modified to make clear that, pursuant to Rule 2.1(c) of the Rules of Procedure of the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation, counsel who have appeared as counsel of record in an action transferred into MDL 2543 **prior to its transfer** into this District need not file a motion for *pro hac vice* admission before this Court. Any attorney who appears in a member case **after its transfer** (or, in a case directly filed in this District, after its filing) must apply for *pro hac vice* status in accordance with Order No. 2. Either way, all counsel in transferred cases are directed to visit the Court's website at <http://www.nysd.uscourts.gov> to apply for CM/ECF filing privileges.
