JESSE M. FURMAN, United States District Judge:

On April 4, 2017, New GM filed a motion to dismiss, without prejudice, the claims of fifty-five economic loss plaintiffs (“Plaintiffs”) who had failed to submit substantially complete plaintiff fact sheets (“PFSs”) as required by Orders No. 45 and 72. (14-MD-2543, Docket No. 3795). Pursuant to those Orders, Plaintiffs had fourteen days — until April 18, 2017 — to file responses either certifying submission of a completed PFS or opposing New GM’s motion for other reasons. Plaintiffs filed an opposition certifying that many of those Plaintiffs had met the PFS requirements. (14-MD-2543, Docket No. 3855). New GM filed a reply on April 26, 2017, indicating it now seeks to dismiss only the thirteen Plaintiffs who failed to submit any response within the required time period. (14-MD-2543, Docket No. 3907). (A list of those Plaintiffs is attached to this Order as **Exhibit A.**)

In light of those thirteen Plaintiffs’ continued failure to submit substantially complete PFSs as required by Order No. 45, the claims of Plaintiffs on Exhibit A are hereby DISMISSED without prejudice. Should any Plaintiff submit all required documentation within the next thirty days, or otherwise contest this dismissal, he or she may move to vacate the dismissal pursuant to Paragraph 4 of Order No. 45.

The Clerk of Court is directed to terminate 14-MD-2543, Docket No. 3795.
