ORDER with respect to [2070] and [2071] Letters Regarding Deposition Designation Disputes. The Court rules on the disputes concerning the DeGiorgio deposition as follows. First, all of Plaintiff's objections to New GM's counter-designations are OVERRULED with the exception of the objection to Tr. 476:11-477:22, which is SUSTAINED except as to Tr. 477:14-15, which should be included (to explain what a "DFMEA" is). Second, all of New GM's objections to Plaintiff's designations are OVERRULED with the exception of the objection to Tr. 490:09-492:22, which is SUSTAINED. The Court will rule on the parties' other disputes (concerning the Parks deposition and PX 136 and 596) in due course. The Court notes one other thing: The Court is inclined to give the jury some explanation of references in the depositions to the "MDL," "MDL Plaintiffs," and the like.
