ORDER with respect to [2137] and [2138] Letters Regarding Deposition Designation Disputes for Jaclyn Palmer and Michael Millikin. The Court resolves the disputes with respect to the Palmer deposition as follows. New GM's objections to the designations are OVERRULED except for (1) New GM's objection to Tr. 41:7-41:17; (2) New GM's objection to Tr. 42:20-42:23; and (3) New GM's objection to Tr. 118:6-118:10, which are SUSTAINED. In addition, New GM's categorical objections to PX-92, PX-106, and PX-108 are OVERRULED, except that those exhibits shall be redacted to conform to the Court's prior rulings (in particular, to redact passages that intrude on the jury's role by, for example, discussing the likelihood of a jury awarding punitive damages). The parties shall meet and confer in an effort to agree on redactions, and shall raise any disagreements with the Court no later than 4:30 p.m. on January 20, 2016. Although Plaintiff's letter discussed PX-89 as well, New GM does not appear to raise an objection to that exhibit in its letter. (HEREBY ORDERED by Judge Jesse M.
