**ORDER with respect to [3519] Motion for Summary Judgment on Successor Liability.** No later than April 18, 2017, the parties shall submit supplemental briefs, not to exceed ten pages, addressing the following questions: (1) Whether the Court should treat the economic loss claims of the pre-2009 Delta Ignition Switch Plaintiffs asserted in the Fourth Amended Consolidated Complaint ("FACC") as having been filed in the first instance in this District and, if so, whether the Court should (assuming federal choice-of-law law does not apply) apply the choice-of-law law of New York State to Plaintiffs' successor liability claims, not based on the Sale Order or bankruptcy proceeding, but because this Court sits in New York, see, e.g., Klaxon Co. v. Stentor Elec. Mfg. Co., 313 U.S. 487, 496 (1941); and (2) what impact, if any, a ruling by the Bankruptcy Court allowing Plaintiffs to file late proofs of claim against the GUC Trust would have on the
